Parents: It is YOUR responsibility to make sure your student is appropriately dressed to avoid embarrassment, frustration, etc. PLEASE take care of this AT HOME!

Girls: Modest, high-necked shirts. If sleeveless, the band/straps should be wide and with no bra straps showing. When you raise your arms you shouldn't be able to see your stomach. When you bend down, you shouldn't be able to see your underwear.

Guys: Shirts – No wife-beaters, cut-off's, or tanks with the wide-open armholes. Tanks/jerseys can be worn for athletic games and activities.

Shorts: Girls and guys are expected to wear modest shorts. Shorts must come at least to mid thigh. We should not be able to see your underwear at any time—from the top or the bottom.

If your attire is deemed inappropriate by the student ministry staff or adult sponsors present, you will be asked to change. Continued violations will be addressed with parents.
