### **Middle Camp Cell Phone Policy**

Our desire is to enjoy a week of Camp without the distraction of cell phones and other technology. However, we understand that many campers have their own phones and will bring them to Camp. If campers bring phones to Camp, please understand that they do so at their own risk. Cabins are not locked, so phones and other valuables will not be secured. **No camper cell phones will be allowed outside of cabins.** Campers are asked to be responsible and make wise decisions regarding cell phone use when they are in their cabins. Counselors and staff have the authority to limit phone use or change this policy at any time during Camp.
